About the Department: Bio-purification of the body to eliminate toxins from the body for the purpose of treating an ailment and rejuvenation is the main concept behind the Panchakarma treatment. The department of Panchakarma is running independently in A & U Tibbia College since September 2008. It has a dedicated Panchakarma Unit with separate sections for consultation and therapy rooms. All the classical Panchakarma like Vaman, Virechana, Basti karma, Nasya, Raktamokshana and all Keraliya panchakarma procedures like Shirodhara, Pinda Sweda etc. are performed here by trained masseurs under the supervision of specialist faculty. There is an associated Physiotherapy unit as well to ensure maximum benefits of Panchakarma therapy.

Because of continues and sincere efforts of faculty and departmental staff Post Graduation course has been started with the intake capacity of 04 students.
